DAY 1

Arrival in Malaga- Transfer to Seville

Discover Seville




Seville is considered the most beautiful city in Andalusia with its stunning baroque facades and monuments. It is home to "Carmen," "Don Juan," and "The Barber of Seville." The city's appearance is striking, blending many historical styles. On the city tour, you'll visit the gigantic Santa Maria Cathedral, the third-largest in Europe, and the Giralda Tower(admission included). Originally built as an Almohad minaret in 1184, it is now part of Seville's cathedral complex. The tour also includes Plaza de España, Maria Luisa Park with its beautiful gardens, and the royal palace Alcazar, originally built in the 12th century and later expanded by Moorish rulers during the reign of Charles V. A walk through the romantic old town of Seville, Barrio Santa Cruz, with its maze of narrow streets, squares, fountains, and flowers, will cap off a day full of experiences.



Embark on a guided tour of Sevilla's most iconic landmarks: Seville Cathedral and La Giralda Tower, one of the largest Gothic cathedrals in the world. Climb the tower for panoramic views; Royal Alcázar of Seville, a stunning Moorish palace with lush gardens featured in movies and series like Game of Thrones; Wander through the Barrio de Santa Cruz, Sevilla's old Jewish Quarter, with its narrow streets, hidden courtyards, and charming plazas.


Seville to Cordoba and Granada

Discover Cordoba



Cordoba, this thousand-year-old city, which has the World Heritage designation, is a living legacy of the different cultures that settled here throughout its history. The old quarter of Cordoba is a beautiful network of narrow streets, alleys, squares and whitewashed courtyards arranged around the Mosque. You will explore the exquisite Cordoba's Mosque-Cathedral (Mezquita admission included) on a walking tour with an art historian guide. It is the most important Islamic monument in the West and one of the most amazing places in the world. Its history summarizes the complete evolution of the Umayyad style in Spain, along with the Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque styles present in the Christian part of the structure.



Afternoons depart to Granada.




Albaicin, Mirador de San Nicolas & Tapas Tour



Upon arrival Discover the Albaicín, Granada's old Moorish quarter. Walk through its labyrinthine streets, visit the Mirador de San Nicolás for the best views of the Alhambra, and soak in the area's unique charm



Evening Meet your local guide to enjoy the most inescapable element of Spanish cuisine: Tapas tour, popular all over the world. In all Spain's cities you will find bars, taverns & markets specialized in tapas. Spend a few hours escorted by an expert guide who will point out little-known cultural and gastronomic landmarks, while listening to the stories and legends of this tapas culture along the way. DAY 4

Alhambra



Today we will enjoy Granada and the Alhambra, a highlight of your trip awaits with a guided visit to the Alhambra.

Explore the Nasrid Palaces, featuring exquisite Islamic art and architecture.

Stroll through the Generalife Gardens, a serene retreat of fountains, flowers, and breathtaking views.

The Alhambra is a palace and fortress complex. It is one of the Wonders of the World and a UNESCO world heritage site. You will discover a unique Arab medieval citadel, probably the best preserved in the world, and also the highest tourist attraction in Spain. Accompanied by your local guide, visit the old Alcazaba, the Nazari Royal Palaces, the Palace of Carlos V or the Generalife, the summer residence of the Nazari monarchs. Admire panoramic city views and feel the atmosphere of the Moorish culture surrounded by the perfumes of the flowers and the murmuring of the water.

Discover Málaga





Afternoon: Start your journey with a guided walking tour of Málaga's historic center: Visit the impressive Alcazaba, a Moorish fortress offering stunning views of the city. Explore the Roman Theatre, a reminder of Málaga's ancient past. Stroll along Calle Larios, the city's elegant shopping street.

DAY 6


Visit Ronda

Your private bus and local guide will pick you up at your hotel in Malaga and drive you to Ronda.




Discover Ronda & Mijas



The city is located above a deep gorge. This gorge separates the new town, which dates from about the 15th century, from the old town, which dates from the time of Moorish rule. At the stone New Bridge that spans the gorge, there is an angle with spectacular views.

Get into the bullring, a legendary historic building from the 18th century, declared an Asset of Cultural Interest and one of the town's most prominent landmarks.

Stop in Mijas on your way back to Malaga and explore its historic quarter with your guide. This picturesque town is famous for its traditional, white-washed buildings, narrow streets adorned with colorful flowers, the donkey taxis and stunning panoramic views of the coastline.
