
Let's Get Started

Arrive Barcelona




At arrival, you´ll meet Spain for Groups assistance. They will help with group coordination through the next days.

- Water & soft drinks on board.




Enjoy a local Paella lunch.

speed trains.




DAY 3

Discover Madrid




Upon arrival lunch at local restaurant followed by Madrid sightseeing

Main Course: Paella: Cooked over an open fire, this iconic dish comes in options like seafood, chicken, or vegetarian. Cochinillo Asado: Roasted suckling pig, a specialty in many rural regions.
